# Who We Are

Green Resources AS (GRAS) was established in 1995 and is a private Norwegian company fully owned by **New Forests**' African Forestry Impact Platform ('AFIP'). GRAS manages 35,000ha of standing forest in Mozambique, Tanzania and Uganda, all established through its own planting activities. GRAS operates industrial facilities including two sawmills, three pole treatment plants and a veneer plant.

GRAS is expanding steadily and is in the process of building two new sawmills in Uganda and Tanzania, and two plywood factories in Mozambique and Tanzania.



#### **Treatment Process**

Our wood undergoes specialized treatment within a dedicated pressure chamber, utilising either the saturation of CCA (Chromated Copper Arsenate) or Creosote. This pressurized treatment method guarantees the prolonged durability of the timber, preventing fungi, insect damage, and mold, making it particularly well-suited for outdoor applications.



Eucalyptus Poles

Our pressure treatment plant produces Creosote (MZ only) as well as CCA (Chromated Copper Arsenate) treated utility poles for power and telecom distribution, as well as fencing posts for home and farming projects.



Veneer & Plywood

NGP produces high quality 8'x4' Eucalyptus plywood in AB and BB grades for export to, mainly, Asian markets. From 2026, GRAS expects to be offering plywood for domestic and export markets.



Forest Products (Pine & Eucalyptus)

We sell standing trees (forest) as well as (roadside/delivered) saw logs and peeler logs to third-party sawmills.



Biomass

We offer a range of sustainable wood fuel products in bulk quantities for, primarily, domestic and industrial use.





#### Kiln Dried Timber

GRAS offers kiln-dried timber, a process designed to prevent warping or the formation of small cracks over time, enhancing durability and usability. Through kiln-drying, up to 90% of the moisture is removed, making the timber resistant to fungal decay. This method also eliminates insects and mold, prolonging the life of the timber.



Certified Heat Treated Timber

GRAS operations can offer pallet material with the IPPC mark that can be used to make food grade packaging materials.



#### Sustainable Charcoal

We offer sustainable (FSC<sup>™</sup> certified) charcoal as an alternative to charcoal from unsustainable indigenous forests. Unsustainable charcoal production in Africa is estimated to emit more than 300m tCO₂e per annum.



#### Tree Seedlings

Our quality tree seedlings and clones are raised by dedicated staff who pay attention to detail. Species raised include *P. tecunumanii*, *P. occarpa*, *P. maximinoi* and various eucalyptus clones.

# Corporate Social Responsibility



GRAS has a strong commitment to creating value for its shareholders and all stakeholders through developing and managing its plantation and industrial operations in a socially responsible manner. This commitment can be seen through our industrial investments, investments in the development of our staff, and communities.

#### Infrastructure

GRAS has opened up, upgraded and on a regular basis maintains community roads in its areas of operation.



#### Education

Social Development Funds have been used to build and rehabilitate education institutes. Education is key to the alleviation of poverty.





#### **Local Communities**

are allowed access to sustainably harvested fuel wood, grass, and fodder. Improved agricultural and tree planting skills and techniques have also been passed on to the local communities.



#### **Community Tree Planting**

Tree seedlings are distributed to communities and institutions to establish private and community woodlots. This is to aid the process of poverty eradication, a millennium development goal for Uganda, Tanzania, and Mozambique.

#### Health Programmes

GRAS has assisted with the expansion of health facilities including the construction of maternity and children wards. GRAS has also constructed housing for medical staff at various clinics as well as upgraded clinic infrastructure for improved access to quality health care. In its areas of operation, the company sponsors NGO programs towards cervical cancer screening and detection.

#### Food Security & **Income Generation**

Social Development Funds have been used to construct food processing facilities and market places to facilitate buying and selling of local produce in a hygienic environment.
