Who We Are

Green Resources AS (GRAS) was established in 1995 and is a private Norwegian company fully owned by **New Forests**' African Forestry Impact Platform ('AFIP'). GRAS manages 35,000ha of standing forest in Mozambique, Tanzania and Uganda, all established through its own planting activities.

In Tanzania, GRAS has two subsidiary companies — established in 2001, GRL Tanzania and Sao Hill Industries (SHI), acquired in 1996 to drive GRAS' industrial development in Tanzania.

GRL comprises a landholding of 35,600ha with 14,350ha of forest plantations in the Iringa province of Tanzania. From that, SHI produces sawn timber, transmission poles and biomass.

GRL has significant expansion potential and in the coming years the plantation resource will be expanded to approximately 2,850ha, making it one of the largest commercial plantations in Tanzania.

Forest Development

GRL has established sustainable forest plantations which supply raw material for the manufacturing of quality timber products.

Corporate Social Responsibility

Tree seedlings are distributed to communities and institutions to establish private and community woodlots.

GRL has an extensive water monitoring programme ensuring the quality of water is not affected by its operations. Water treatment for drinking water is also provided to villages near its operations.

Our Products & Services



Eucalpytus Poles

Kiln-dried, pressure treated (with CCA - Chromated Copper Arsenate) utility poles for power and telecom distribution, as well as fencing posts for home and farming projects.



CCA Treated Timber

Our timber is treated in a specialized pressure chamber. 12.6 bars of pressure is applied within the chamber which forces the CCA (Chromated Copper Arsenate) treatment to penetrate deep into the timber (20-25mm depth). This pressured treatment process ensures the longevity of the timber to stop fungi, insect damage and mold and is perfect for outdoor application.



Kiln-dried Timber

SHI offers kiln-dried timber, a process designed to prevent warping or the formation of small cracks over time, enhancing durability and usability. Through kiln-drying, up to 90% of the moisture is removed, making the timber resistant to fungal decay. This method also eliminates insects, larvae, eggs, bugs, and mold, prolonging the life of the timber. Our timber is well-suited for construction and furniture needs.



Certified Heat Treated Timber

SHI operates a state-of-the-art kiln to produce high quality timber. SHI also posesses the IPPC mark and certification for timber that can be used to make food grade packaging materials.





Forest Products (Pine and Eucalyptus)

GRL sells standing trees (forest) as well as (roadside/delivered) logs to third-party customers.



Biomass

We offer a range of sustainable wood fuel products in bulk quantities. These include pine and eucalyptus firewood, wood chips, and sawdust. We also offer clean dry wood shavings that can be used for animal bedding.



Our tree seedlings are produced to the highest quality, ensuring a high value crop. A variety of Pine hybrids and Eucalyptus hybrids are available.


